
MACMILLAN FUNDRAISER:

Dear Parent/Guardian,

I'm sure most of you have already heard yesterday's announcement by the First and Deputy First Minister regarding new measures being put in place to help lower the spread of Corona Virus.

It was announced, "there will be a two week circuit breaker closure of all schools, commencing Monday 19^{th} October, with potential for review at the end of a two week period. Remote learning and childcare for vulnerable pupils and children of key workers are not required to be provided".

As a result of this announcement school will be closing from Monday 19th October 2020 for an extended half term break. The pupils and staff will then return on Monday 2nd November 2020.

This period of closure is basically an extension of our scheduled half-term break. School will not be open to Key Worker children during this time, nor are we to provide online learning during this fortnight, as the announcement states.

We are sorry that these measures have to be put in place, but we must adhere to the restrictions announced yesterday for the health and safety of everyone.

We have been informed that from week beginning 19th October, direct payments will be made to pupils in receipt of Free School Meals.

Thank you for your understanding and support with the measures we have had to put in place and we hope you and your families stay safe during this extended half term break, and beyond. Please follow the guidelines set out by the Government. If we all play our part we will reduce the spread of this virus and thus avoid more lockdowns and restrictions, and help save lives.
