STARTING DATES AND HOLIDAYS - (SUBJECT TO COVID GUIDANCE)

A holiday list will accompany this News Sheet today.

All pupils will start on Wednesday 25th August 2021, P1-P5 finishing at 12:30pm and P6-7 at 12.40pm everyday that week to enable staff training.

Please note:

- ♦ There will be NO school dinners or transport available in August. Both these will recommence from Wednesday 1st September, 2021.
- Quality Pupils must not be in school before 8.45am as supervision will not be available.

Information will be forwarded with regards to both Breakfast Club and After School's Club, when Government Regulations regarding COVID 19 are released in September.

From Wednesday 1st September:

- ♦ P1+P2 will remain in school to 2pm (Monday Friday)
- OP3 will remain in school to 2pm (Monday Wednesday and Friday) and to 3pm (Tuesday and Thursday)
- ♦ P4-P7 will remain in school each day to 3pm

FREE SCHOOL MEALS/UNIFORM/TRANSPORT GRANTS (for September 2021):

The number of free school meals in a school determines how much extra funding is received. This extra money greatly benefits everyone. If you feel you may be eligible please apply at www.eani.org.uk/i-want-to, even if your child will not always eat them. Information on criteria for these grants can be found on the Education Authority (EA) website. We would encourage you to apply as soon as possible to ensure this is in place for September 2021. Until approval is given by the EA school meals will have to be paid.

Please note: Free school meals / uniform grants must be applied for annually. However, once you have been granted transport you only need to reapply if you change address.
