Please read the following information carefully and reply where necessary as soon as possible.

SCHOOL TIMES: 9.00am-3.00pm (commencing Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> September)

No child is to be on the school premises (apart from Breakfast Club pupils) before 8.45am as there will be NO supervision before this time!

Access to school is only through the Tildarg Road entrance. Please press the buzzer to gain admittance (after 9am). The door will not be locked until 9.00am each morning.

- Opening 8.15am Breakfast Club (in school hall) NO playground supervision!
  - 8.45am Supervision in playground begins
  - 9.00am School Begins.
- Closing P1/2 finish at 2.00pm
  - P3 finish at 2.00pm on Monday and Friday / 3.00pm rest of week.
  - P4-7 finish at 3.00pm

To save embarrassment and interruption to lessons, please make sure your children are punctual.

Miss McCullough and Mrs Stewart have other classes at 2.00pm, so please collect your children **promptly** at the school gate. Should you be held up for any reason, please ring the school.

\*Please Note: If you wish your child to walk home on their own, or cross the lane/road, please inform the school in writing at the beginning of each school year, giving your permission for this.

Once children leave the premises, they are no longer the school's responsibility.

Tildarg Lane must be kept free of traffic at all times.

<u>Taxi</u> - Transport begins Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> September.

<u>Breakfast Club</u> - £2.00 per day. Opens at 8.15am. Last orders at 8.30am. Money for this to be paid directly to Mrs Tosh, either daily or weekly.

<u>After School Club</u> - £2.00 per day. For P1-P3 from 2.00-3.00pm. Money to be paid directly to Mrs Close, preferably on a Monday morning.

\* Please tell your child when/if they are to stay.

**Please ensure** the above monies are sent in **SEPARATE named envelopes**. These monies are lodged separately, therefore the **correct amount** must be sent in for **each activity** above.

Change is NOT available. I apologise for any inconvenience this causes.

### CONTACTING SCHOOL:

To reduce interruption to teaching, please try to contact school within the following times:

8.30-8.50am and 3.00-4.00pm, except in an emergency.

Outside these times, please leave your name, number and a short message, and your query will be dealt with as soon as possible. If you need to speak to your child's teacher about any concern, you **must** contact the Principal first.

### PTA AGM:

### ABSENCE NOTES:
